GRACEPOINT COMMUNITY CHURCH FRIEND DAY (SIGNS FROM GOD)

Max and I first came to Gracepoint on friend day in October of 2008. Before that we were attending a church in Montgomery. We began going to this particular church because our daughter Rachel wanted to go there. When Rachel stopped going to church, so did Max. I still attended alone. I began praying that God would help me to find a church that Max and I could serve together in. Max had told me many times if he ever found a church that truly taught God's word from the Bible he would not only attend but he would get involved. So I began searching and visiting churches in Montgomery and Prattville but none seemed to be the right place. I was talking with my friend Lisa Robinson about it one day and we decided to search together.

One Sunday morning I was driving to Lisa's house and I was thinking about how in the Old Testament people knew beyond a shadow of doubt when God was sending them a sign. I wondered if God sent me a sign would I recognize it as being sent from him? Just then I passed Shoney's on 231 and the marquee out front read "CHURCH OF THE WEEK GRACEPOINT" I thought okay did God just say "Here's your sign?" When I get to Lisa's house she shows me a flyer that she found on her car. It was from GracePoint announcing the grand opening in the new building.

That night I was telling Max about the Shoney's sign and the flyer on Lisa's car and I asked him if he would go with us. He agreed to come. When the four of us walked in (Tim came as well) we could all feel something different at GracePoint. Max was restless all night the night of our visit and was so moved he was up at 2:00 in the morning writing the following article. The article was posted online and was in the Wetumpka Herald. Three years later we still feel like something is

different at GPCC. We're still traveling a 30 minute drive to Wetumpka to be there in time to teach Sunday school where as four years ago we weren't even going to a church 10 minutes away for worship service that starts later than GracePoint! Tim and Lisa Robinson have begun and continue to faithfully serve in a homeless ministry called Church Without Walls.

Friend Day can make a difference! Just think for a minute. You may get a lot of "No's." You may only get one person to attend. You may feel your efforts are fruitless. But... What if..."that one 'yes' becomes the next "Billy Graham" and saves millions of souls? You never know the power of God.

As the sermon came to a close it was evident that Pastor Adam had touched the hearts of many of the people attending the service. Several went to the front during a time of prayer, kneeling and taking the time to talk with God one on one. A young girl in her teens that was so touched that she began to cry.

After a few minutes she turned to her father and they both walked to the front to talk to the pastor. It was very heartwarming to see how touched she was and to see that she wanted to be a part of this church.

Why not start your healing spiritual journey as we begin our new Step Study Group? Our Orientation Meeting will be **September 8, 2011 at 6:30pm - at GPCC**. Celebrate Recovery uses the 12 Steps, the 8 Principles and their related Scripture as the biblical model for living our lives. A Step Study is a personal journey though each of these steps in a confidential group lead by a facilitator who has completed a study. We have guidelines for the groups that are strictly adhered to. The leadership team of this group is Debbie Woodard – Leader and Timi Edwards – Co-Leader.

We use Celebrate Recovery's four participant guides as we progress through them in group. When you have finished walking out the steps in the study, you will have worked through your hurts, habits, and hang-ups. A Step Study is a long-term commitment to the members of the group. It will take 9-10 months to complete the study with a meeting each Thursday night from 6:30 – 8:30 PM. The group will remain open to new members joining us through the first study guide. From Step Book Study Guide 2 on, we will close the group and no additional newcomers will be allowed. You are not required to attend Tuesday night Celebrate Recovery to be a part of the Step Study Group. After completing the Step Study, we hope you will join with us as we minister to others dealing with their hurts, habits and hang-ups. *Note: the cost of the set of 4 Step Study Books are \$20.00 and are required to participate in the program. We do offer payment arrangements of as little as \$1.00 per week if needed.*

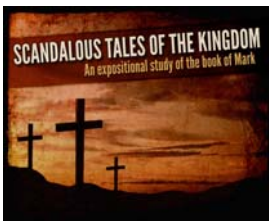
SOULFIRE STUDENT MINISTRY VISION FOR 2011

GRACEPOINT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES

Dive IN Sunday School Class is led by Brandon Scroggins and Terry White. We meet in the Children’s Church classroom. We are currently going verse by verse through the Book of James.

New Feasts of the Lord Class God’s Appointed Times are like a doctor’s appointment – God has made an appointment to meet with you at a specific date, time, and place. These appointments are found in Leviticus Chapter 23 and are referred to as The Feasts of the Lord or God’s Appointed Times. There are seven feasts: Pass-over, Unleavened Bread, First Fruits, Pentecost, The Feast of Trumpets (Rosh HaShanah), The Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur), and The Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkot).

The purpose of this study is to increase your faith and knowledge of the scriptures. We’ll study the historical, messianic, and spiritual aspects of each feast, and we’ll see how God is always on time for His appointments. In Luke 24: 44-45 Jesus says, *“This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms.”* This study shows you how Jesus does this - in the past and in the future.

The new Feasts of the Lord class will begin on August 14 and will be lead by Luke Garner. It will be held in the Journey classroom, across from the copier.

The GAP Sunday School Class is the only **all Ladies class** at GPCC and is facilitated by Debbie Woodard . We meet in the Kitchen each Sunday morning at **9:00 AM**. We are currently studying the Gospel of John, and your study guide will be provided for you if you decide to join theclass. Our class encourages open discussion as we take verse by verse from one of the books of the Bible written by the “disciple that Jesus loved”. You are welcome to join our class at any time. We are a small group at present, and if you are looking for a class that will help you understand God’s word and how to apply it to your everyday life, this is it! - It's a great distraction from the stresses and rigors of life. Any time you can change your focus from the negative emotions of your day, even for just a few moments, the better off you are.

The bottom line is that laughing is one of the best natural health remedies. So, if your stress levels are mounting, if you are feeling unhealthy, if you are feeling rundown and depressed, or you just want some relief...LAUGH! - 1 can of Eagle Brand Sweetened Condensed Milk
- 1 cup Chopped Pecans
- 1 cup Flaked Coconut (optional)

Melt butter in 9"x13" pan. Sprinkle graham cracker crumbs over the butter. Sprinkle chocolate chips over the graham cracker crumbs. Pour the Eagle Brand milk evenly over the chocolate chips. Sprinkle the pecans over the Eagle Brand milk. Top with flaked Coconut, if desired. Bake @ 350 degrees for 25 to 30 minutes.
